Substrate Requirements

Good to prepare surfaces. Apply EZ2KV as a first coat to achieve maximum coverage.

Surface Preparation

All surfaces must be thoroughly cleaned and free of all loose dirt, dust, grease, loose or flaking paint, and loose surface plaster. Efflorescence or mould on masonry or concrete surfaces must be treated. Flatten gloss surfaces by thoroughly sanding and wiping clean with a damp cloth, then apply primer, sealer or undercoat as required. For best results on exterior substrates such as timber, brick, blockwork, and compressed fibre cement sheet.

Mixing

Mix with a slow-speed drill and helical spinner head for 60 seconds. Mix until uniform.



A completely clean surface is mandatory to ensure inter-coat adhesion, especially at long recoating intervals. Any dirt, oil, and grease must be removed, e.g., with a suitable detergent. Salts should be removed by freshwater hosing. To check the adequate

quality of the surface cleaning a test patch is recommended before actual recoating.

Recoating and drying/curing time

2 hours @25°C/50% relative humidity. Undercooler or more humid conditions allow longer drying times. If recoating with a solvent-based paint, allow 1-Step to dry for 24hr before recoating.
